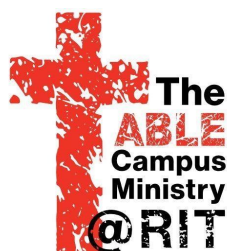


## **SECOND SUNDAY OF EASTER**
